Riverwood Community Centre with the help of the Mangahmi Mgallia Aboriginal Corporation (MMAC) is leading the way in Canterbury Bankstown to help build awareness in our local community about the Uluru Statement and the upcoming referendum.

On the 1st November our Aged Care Vietnamese group enjoyed putting together their lovely fascinators and their accessories to celebrate the Melbourne Cup.




Mark Coure visiting the Riverwood Community Centre Community Garden on the 30th September
