## **Information for families:**

Dear Parent/ Guardians

We would like to welcome all children and parents to Riverwood Community Vacation Care and we hope that you have a wonderful time in our service.

#### **Enrolment**

- All cancellations will require <u>2 weeks written notice</u> to the booked Vacation care day. Please note staffing is organised, excursions and incursion are already paid for based on numbers booked two weeks prior to the program commencing.
- Added days may be accepted for Vacation care depending on the number of existing bookings and staff ratio on the requested days.

#### **Fees**

- No Family will be eligible to enrol into vacation Care unless all fees (BASC and Vacation Care) are up to date INCLUDING any outstanding fees.
- Payment option: Direct Debit ONLY

## **Childcare Subsidy**

- Families may be eligible for Child Care Subsidy. All issues regarding these levels must be discussed with Centrelink. https://www.education.gov.au/ChildCarePackage
- Families must sign their child off on the last day of care for CCS to apply. This includes the last day of the 2-week notification period.

#### Food/ Meals

 Children MUST bring morning tea, lunch and afternoon tea, a refillable water bottle to all in centre and excursion days unless otherwise stated on the program. Please check every day of the program activities for more information.

## **Arrival and Departure from centre**

- All children MUST be signed IN and OUT by a parent/guardian or emergency contact when arriving/ leaving the centre.
- No child will be allowed to leave the centre with any person other than a parent/guardian or emergency contact stated on enrolment form unless they have contacted the service due to an emergency.
- On excursion days the children must be at the centre NO LATER than
   9.00am (unless otherwise stated on the program, please ensure you have reviewed each days programmed activities for information)
- On centre days the children must be at the centre NO LATER than
   9.30am (unless otherwise stated)
- All children MUST be picked up from the centre NO LATER than
   6.00pm SHARP otherwise late fees will be applied.
- When Plan B (variation from program) is implemented, a message will be sent out via OWNA app and/or a note will be displayed on the service information board in the morning to inform all parents.

A late pick-up fee will be charged when children are collected from the centre after 6.00pm.

In the event parent/guardians and emergency contacts are uncontactable after 1 hour the supervisor will implement the Department of Education and Communities Abandoned Child Procedure, i.e. contact Child Protection Helpline 24 hours service on 133 627.



## **Behaviour management**

Unacceptable behaviour such as bullying, harassment or intimidation will not be tolerated at any time. Any child who exhibits behaviour that places the wellbeing of other children, themselves or staff at risk will be excluded from the service immediately. If centre staff, contact the parent/guardian/emergency contact requesting a pickup this must be done immediately. Educators will make every effort to manage challenging behaviours through positive behaviour management techniques; however, when this has been attempted and is unsuccessful then it is the parent's responsibility to collect the child/ren or arrange alternative arrangements.

There are several reasons where it may be necessary for a child/family to be excluded from the service. (As per our policies and procedures)

- The behaviour of the child is endangering themselves or others.
- The behavior requires extensive supervision from staff that may be to the detriment of other children in attendance of the program.
- The behavior of the child is extremely insolent, disruptive to the program, persistently non-compliant, violent / aggressive towards educators and children.
- Repeated and frequently late collection of a child by parents and carers.
- Fees are largely outstanding, consistently unpaid by parents/ guardians.

If you need any clarification about the above, please do not hesitate to discuss with Educators or the Director/Nominated Supervisors.

#### Medication

No child will be administered medication unless a medication authorization form has been filled out and signed by the parent/guardian each day and the medication are in its original package.

## Asthma, Anaphylaxis, Other Medical Conditions

All Medical conditions, Action Plans & Risk Management Plans must be discussed and given to Nominated Supervisor prior to child's start date and updated based on doctor's advice.
